





Transition year 2024-2025

- If there is any questions about TY, please feel free to ask me after the presentation.




What is Transition year?




- Transition Year (also called TY) is a one-year programme between Junior Cycle and Senior Cycle.
- It is designed to act as a bridge between the two by helping the transition of the more dependent learning of the Junior Cycle to the more independent self-directed learning required for the Senior Cycle





- Engage in independent, self directed learning
- Develop general, technical and academic skills.
- Develop work related skills
- Develop social skills
- Mature and develop without the pressure of state exams
- Become more motivated for the leaving certificate

Cost Breakdown




Start of Year - €500











Trip to Coláiste Uisce

Coláiste Uisce is an Gaeltacht water adventure centre in County Mayo.






International Trip






Benefits of Transition Year
