We are excited to announce that our Transition Year students will be going on an exciting trip to Coláiste Uisce, Belmullet, Co. Mayo, <u>from 15th to 17th of September</u>. This trip will be a wonderful opportunity for students to immerse themselves in the Gaeltacht, improve their Irish language skills, and take part in a variety of engaging activities, including land activities, water sports, and exciting evening games.

## **Trip Details:**

• **Dates:** 15th to 17th of September

• **Destination:** Coláiste Uisce, Belmullet, Co. Mayo

• **Travel:** Students will travel by private coach.

• Activities: Land activities, water sports, and night activities

• Cost: €320 (includes accommodation, meals, all activities, and travel)

## **Payment Details:**

- Deposit of €80 is due by May 23rd.
- The remaining balance of  $\leq 240$  must be paid by **September 8th.**

While this trip provides a fantastic opportunity to enhance Irish language skills, we want to emphasise that students who do not study Irish are not excluded from the trip. We encourage all students to join, as the activities are designed to be fun and educational for everyone.
